"A 1949 certificate from the Inter-Village Produce Association (VPA) awarding a Certificate of Merit to Hindolveston VPA has been handed in to the Parish Council by a descendant of the Wakefield family who live(d) in the village. VPA's were encouraged after the end of WW2 along with the slogan 'Dig for Britain' to promote growth of fruit and vegetables which were in short supply after the war ended (rationing continued until 1952). Hindolveston clearly had a VPA in 1949 - does anyone remember when it shut down? Scanning the web, many villages still have active VPA's set up as charities with regular meetings, sales of produce and any profits going to worthy village causes. Food for thought??
